

Utah SUN Bucks is a grocery benefits program to help families buy food during the summer when schools are closed. Families can get \$120 for each eligible school-age child.



How do I get SUN Bucks?

If you did **NOT** fill out a free meal application this year, but everyone in your school receives free lunch (including your children), you need to apply for SUN Bucks.



How do I apply?

You can apply online starting April 28, 2025, at <u>jobs.utah.gov/SUNBucks</u>. Paper applications are also available at any Workforce Services Employment Center



How can I use SUN Bucks?

SUN Bucks will be sent to you on an EBT card this summer. The money can be used to buy foods like fruits, vegetables, meat, whole grains and dairy at grocery stores, farmers markets and other places that accept SNAP benefits.
